- After puppy pick up your puppy will be missing its siblings, mother, and family environment it has known since birth. There is a possibility of stresses for your puppy in this transition, yet some puppies do well others may need some time for adjusting to new home. Puppies can get sick from changes of food, and being in new environment by having loose stools or getting sick. Puppies going through the transition will cry at night, cry when not being comforted during this time, and they will want to always be with you for comfort. This new adjustment can take up anywhere up to two weeks. *Are you willing and prepared to handle this puppies transition situation with love and by giving comfort during this time of transition?

- Will you give your pet fresh food, and fresh water in clean bowls daily?
- Will you be committed to giving the dog a healthy dog food diet?
- Will you feed your pet table scraps?
- Are you prepared to handle your puppies chewing needs while they are teething? (example bones, chews, toys, pig ears etc.)
- Are you prepared to have a consistent continuous effort to potty train your puppy? (potty training can take months without consistency and patience)
- Do you have other pets? Please explain and list the breed of dogs.
- Do you have children? If so, how old are they? (If you don't have children skip next two questions)
- Will your guide your children how to hold, care, be gentle with your new puppy/dog addition?
- Will you supervise your children and other pets around your new puppy/dog?
